The winners of the show will be announced on July 21, 2018 at the Renaissance Ball to be held at the historic Jackson Terminal building located at 205 West Jackson Avenue in Knoxville.

The Renaissance Ball is a celebration to recognize the efforts of providing a scholarship fund to aid our senior friends with the expense of assisted living.

This show is open to all artists 50 years of age and older residing in East Tennessee. The artwork should provide one or more of the following:

*A response to the theme of "My Life, My Art in East Tennessee

*Pertinence to the themes of Community, Family and History in East Tennessee

There is a \$5.00 entry fee per piece (payable to Renaissance Terrace) Each artist may submit up to three pieces for consideration.

All artwork and applications should be delivered to the

Emporium Center at 100 South Gay Street in Knoxville between 9:00am – 4:00pm on Monday, July 2, 2018.

All submitted work will be considered for entry to the show.

Artists will be notified which of their entries have been chosen to be entered in the show on Tuesday, July 3rd.

Artists are responsible to pick up any art not chosen for competition on

Tuesday, July 3rd, Thursday, July 5th or Friday, July 6th between 9:00am - 5:00pm.

The Emporium will be CLOSED on July 4th.

- *All artwork must be picked up between 9:00am 4:00pm on Monday, July 30th.
 - All work not picked up will become the property of Renaissance Terrace

The "My Life, My Art in East Tennessee" Art Show will open on Friday, July 6, 2018.

All artists and friends are invited to attend an opening night celebration scheduled from 6:00pm – 8;00pm on "Opening Night" Friday, July 6, 2018 at the Emporium Center.

The artwork will be displayed in the galleria of the Emporium for the remainder of the month of July.

All artwork must be picked up by 4:00pm on Monday, July 30, 2018.

*Entries must be original works in the following categories:

Painting (oil, watercolor, acrylic, pastel, digital and mixed media)

Graphic Arts (pencil, charcoal, pen and ink, conte, colored pencil and print making)

Photography (color, black and white and digital)

3 – D (hanging or free-standing, sculpture, ceramic, fibers, ect...)

Objects Fine Craft (basketry, weaving, etc...)

*Giclees are ineligible

- All artwork can be priced and sold during the show. All sales are handled by the Arts and Culture Alliance, who retains a 25% commission (20% for cash and check sales). To operate in accordance with the Tennessee Department of Revenue guidelines, the Alliance will add sales tax to the price of each work that sells from the Emporium and for which it collects payment. Sold works are to remain in the exhibition until the official closing date and time, unless an alternate arrangement can be reached that is mutually agreeable to the Alliance, the artist and the purchaser of the work.
- ordinary wear and tear. The Alliance shall not be liable for damage or loss caused by war, confiscation, order of any government or public authority, or by any and all causes beyond the control of the Alliance. The Alliance agreed to notify an artist within 36 hours by telephone, email and/or by written notification upon the event of any theft, damage or loss that occurs while artwork is in the possession of the Alliance. In the event of loss or damage to artwork at fault of the Alliance, the Alliance agrees to compensate up to reasonable market value on each artwork as agreed upon by Artist and the Alliance's Executive Director.
- Unless otherwise specified, ACA will insure up to \$25,000.00 on all artwork in the Emporium throughout the exhibition. If necessary, Artist will insure work above that amount. Unclaimed

hand-delivered work is not insured after the posted pick-up date. It is the artist's responsibility to provide all insurance and shipping costs on works during shipment.
